MINUTES OF PRE-BID MEETING FOR SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION, TRAINING, TESTING AND COMMISSIONING OF INSTRUMENT LANDING SYSTEM (ILS) FOR TRAINING AT EAST AFRICAN SCHOOL OF AVIATION HELD ON THURSDAY, 6<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY, 2021; TENDER NO. KCAA/038/2021 – 2022.

### 1. Objective of the meeting

Kenya Civil Aviation herein referred to as KCAA invited bids for the supply, delivery, installation, training, testing and commissioning of an Instrument Landing System for training at East African School of Aviation on **Thurday,6**<sup>th</sup> **January,2021**. Prospective bidders were notified in the advert and in the bidding documents that a mandatory prebid meeting would be held on **Thursday, 6th November, 2021** at **11.30** a.m. at East African School of Aviation.

This pre-bid meeting was to accord the interested bidders an opportunity to seek clarifications pertaining to the invitation to tender for the stated works.

## 2. Attendance of the meeting

The meeting started as per the scheduled time and was attended by **Eighteen (18)** interested bidders' representatives and **three (3)** representatives of KCAA.
