1.	The determination shall be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Tenderer's qualifications submitted by the Tenderer, pursuant to ITT 15.1. The determination shall not take into consideration the qualifications of other firms such as the Tenderer's subsidiaries, parent entities, affiliates, subcontractors (other than Specialized Subcontractors if permitted in the Tendering document) or any other firm (s) different from the Tenderer. Question 1: Kindly confirm if a bidder can rely on the qualifications of a Specialized Subcontractor to meet these requirements.	Yes, a bidder can rely on the qualifications of a Specialized Subcontractor to meet these requirements. The bidder shall provide documentary evidence to demonstrate that the specialized contractor meets the specific qualifications requirement as per the requirements of the tender document. Bidder or sub-contractors must be the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM).

On the introduction and general briefs on the DVOR/DME project pre-bid meeting from the clarifications sent on 3rd February 2025 - QN1: On point 10 - Kindly clarify on the power connection sequence from the KPLC meter box to the shelter. QN2: On point 12- decommissioning of the current burnt structure. Kindly clarify if disposal is to be done and to which place. QN3: on point 13 - check and ensure that a proper earthing of the entire structure is attained. Kindly clarify or explain the way forward if the earthing conditions are done and found not suitable 	Power is supplied from the KPLC meter box using an underground armoured cable to the equipment/ shelter distribution board as stipulated in the tender document under 1.15 Control Functions/ indicators item (ix) electrical works. QN2 The decommissioned structure shall be removed from the DVOR/DME site and transported to the RADAR site which is within Wajir Airport, approximately 3 km away.

		QN3 The site has an existing earthing and if the earthing is found not suitable, the bidder is required to ensure a proper earthing resistance of less than 5Ω is attained.	
3.	Please clarify whether a Kenya based company can use its mother company's references for all kind of navaids as experience requirement.	Yes. The bidder shall provide documentary evidence of the relationship with the parent company and the subsidiaries including ownership documents.	
4.	Can a Kenya based company bid as the lead using original equipment manufacturer authorization?.	Yes. However, the lead bidder shall provide documentary evidence to support the local bidder including providing resources and technical personnel with the requisite expertise and experience during the installation and maintenance of the equipment. Further, the bidder shall provide a teaming agreement showing the responsibilities for each. The Manufacturer SHALL also extend the warranty for the equipment to the Authority. Bidder or sub-contractors must be the OEM.	
5.	As the life of most ANS equipment is 20 years is it possible to extend the experience from 7 to 20 Years.		
6.	Factory Training and Factory Acceptance Tests (FAT).	KCAA clarifies that there will be Three (3) Officers for Factory Training and NOT Six (6) officers. The three (3) officers will also conduct the Factory Acceptance Tests (FAT). The number of days will however remain the same as indicated in the tender document for both DVOR/DME.	
7.	Onsite Training	KCAA clarifies that the Site training at Wajir shall be conducted for Six (6) technical personnel. However, the number of days for training stated in the tender for both DVOR/DME shall remain the same.




Fig. 2-3 Foundations for DVOR counterpoise and shelter (for information only)
